The Luck Town board meeting was called to order at 7:30 by Town Chairman, Dean Johansen. Other members present were Town Supervisor Greg Marsten, Larry Wright, Clerk Patsy Gustafson, Treasurer Laurie Ince and also Aaron Valleen. Notice for the Town meeting was posted in the Leader.

Agenda for this meeting was posted in the Luck Town hall, the Countryside Co-op and the Wayne's Grocery Store.

Questions/comments - Nothing referred to county health department discussion on Hwy 48

October minutes were presented. - a motion by Larry to approve the minutes. Seconded by Greg. Motion carried.

Town Chair Report - Ambulance vote was not unanimous to merge so will merge in 2023. The Luck Fire Dept did raise their levy.

Treasurer's report balance of \$145,830.11 at the end of October. After paying the bills there is a balance of \$136,670.32 Dean made a motion to accept the treasurer's report. Larry seconded it. Motion carried.

After reviewing the bills, Greg made a motion to pay all bills for \$9,159.79. Larry seconded it. Motion carried.

Discuss participation in the Large Livestock Ordinance Town Partnership. It is a six town partnership and will produce an operational ordinance. We will look at it in the spring.

Discuss traffic issues on roads. Dean met with a state trooper re: 140th and the truck traffic (we have plenty of signs for no thru truck traffic) but we need a more specific ordinance so that they can ticket. So a Class B designation for year round weight limit (48,000 gross weight limit) Designate 140th from 48 to 300th Ave, 150th from village to 35, 260th from 48 to 35 and 170th from 240th to 300th to Class B - Dean made a motion to pass an Ordinance at the next meeting. Greg seconded it. Motion carried.

Patrolman's report - Aaron - Patching and shouldering being done and putting up road signs. Monarch cored six places - ranged (2",2",1-7/8",2",1-7/8",2-1/8") they have been doing 3" for truck traffic and 2-1/2 for regular roads and recommend crack fill every few years.

Motion by Dean to adjourn. Seconded by Larry. Motion carried.
